TEAM ADULT ADVISOR GUIDELINES**

The Washington State Prevention Summit presents a great opportunity for youth teams to come together to learn new prevention strategies and take advantage of networking opportunities and activities.

In accordance with the Chaperone Guidelines for the Summit, there must be one adult to every three youth. For teams, one of the chaperones should be designated as the Team Adult Advisor. In addition to the chaperone duties, the Team Adult Advisor must fulfill the following responsibilities:

- To attend and participate in the Prevention Summit Youth Leadership Track and service project with my team of youth.
- To commit to supporting my team and work to create a team project to implement in our community.
- Is the main contact between the Summit committee and the team in regards to instructions, notifications, and follow up.
